



## Guidance on filling in the “Application form” and “End-user-statement form” (application for individual export control license or for global export control license).

*Please be aware that field 13 to field 18 (in italics below) are only relevant for applicants, whose item is considered a dual use item as well as a mineral resource product pursuant to “the Mineral Resource Act” in Greenland. This means that by applying for an export control license by filling in field 13 to field 18 in the “Application form” the applicant will not have to make a separate application for an export permit pursuant to the “The Mineral Resource Act”*

**Field 1: Exporter:** Means any natural or legal person or partnership on whose behalf an export declaration is made, that is to say the person who, at the time when the declaration is accepted, holds the contract with the consignee in the third country and has the power for determining the sending of the item out of the customs territory of Greenland. If no export contract has been concluded or if the holder of the contract does not act on its own behalf, the exporter shall mean the person who has the power for determining the sending of the item out of the customs territory of Greenland;

An exporter shall also mean any natural or legal person or partnership, which decides to transmit or make available software or technology by electronic media including by fax, telephone, electronic mail or by any other electronic means to a destination outside of Greenland.

**Field 2: Consignee:** The person to whom the items will be delivered.

**Field 3: Agent:** If a broker or an agent is participating in the export arrangement name, address, e-mail etc. of the agent has to be stated.

**Field 4: End-user:** In this field please insert the following information about the end-user: name, address, country, phone numbers, e-mail etc.

**Field 5: Civil or military end-use:** Please mark with an “X” whether the end-use will be military or civil.

**Field 6: Country of origin:** Fill in information about the country of origin if available. Please also use the “country codes” published by the European Union in the Geonomenclature. If assistance is needed, please contact the Greenlandic Tax Agency ([tax@nanoq.gl](mailto:tax@nanoq.gl)).

**Field 7: Country of final destination:** Fill in information about the country of final destination if available. For further information about “country code” please see “Field 6” above.

**Field 8: Description of the items:** Please include information about brand, type, quantity and a general description of the item. The description shall be sufficient detailed so the product can be identified. Please specify whether the product easily can be obtained on the world market. If the field is too small please include a separate enclosure. If the item is a chemical product please state CAS no. and CUS no. Further information on CAS No. and CUS No. can be found on [http://ec.europa.eu/taxation\\_customs/dds2/ecics/chemicalsubstance\\_consultation.jsp?Lang=en](http://ec.europa.eu/taxation_customs/dds2/ecics/chemicalsubstance_consultation.jsp?Lang=en)

**Field 9: CN-Code:** Please use the eight-digits-long code from the Combined Nomenclature published by the European Union. If assistance is needed, please contact the Tax Agency in Greenland ([tax@nanoq.gl](mailto:tax@nanoq.gl)).

**Field 10: Control list No :** Number from the Control List published by the Danish Business Authority. For further information please see the following link: <https://danishbusinessauthority.dk/eu-legislation-on-export-controls> or contact the Ministry of Industry and Energy ([isiin@nanoq.gl](mailto:isiin@nanoq.gl)).

**Field 11: Value:** Economic value in DKK.

**Field 12: Quantity:** Quantity stated in kg or other relevant unit.

**Field 13: Type of minerals:** *Please state the type of minerals. Only necessary if the item is considered as mineral resource product pursuant to the [Mineral Resource Act in force in Greenland](#).*

**Field 14: Average grade of uranium in ore  $\geq 0.05$  %:**  
*Please state the average concentration of uranium when export of ores will exceed 500 kg and the average grade of uranium is 0.05 % or more.*

**Field 15: Average grade of thorium in ore  $\geq 0.05$  %:**  
*Please state the average concentration of thorium when export of ores will exceed 500 kg and the average grade of thorium is 0.05 % or more.*

**Field 16: Processing product code no:**  
*Use code 2530.90.98.0 for raw stones/minerals and code 9602.00.00.0 for processed stones/minerals. If processed please include a description of the processing as an enclosure.*

**Field 17: Quality:** *Divide the stones/minerals into gemstones and not gemstones.*

**Field 18: Collection site (license code):** *License code issued by the Mineral License and Safety Authority (MLSA) pursuant to the [Mineral Resource Act in force in Greenland](#).*

**Field 19: End-use:** Please give a complete and detailed description of the intended end use. The description shall include information about whether the final use has a military or civilian purpose.

**Field 20: Order/Contract date:** If the export is based on a commercial contract, please state date of order/ date of contract.

**Field 21: Customs export procedure:** Please state the customs export procedure, which will be used in connection to the exportation. The following codes shall be used:

- 10 Permanent exportation.
- 101 Permanent exportation for the purpose of reparation or maintenance.
- 23 Temporary exportation but with the intention of a re-import in unchanged state e.g. exhibition or demonstration.
- 31 Re-exportation, i.e. exportation of items from Greenland, which do not origin (not made/excavated) in Greenland.

**Field 22: Additional information:**  
If the applicant is applying for an individual export license, the total amount and value of

the items, which are listed in the application, need to be specified. If the items listed in application are part of a larger order, which includes items where no export control licenses are required then the value of the total order shall be added.

**Field 23: Catch-all Provision:**

If the product is not listed on the "control list" (<https://danishbusinessauthority.dk/eu-legislation-on-export-controls>), the export control authority might in some cases request an export control license cf. section. 4 of law No. 616, 2016.

- I. Export control license shall be required for, if the exporter has been informed by the export control authority that the items question are or may be intended, in their entirety or in part, for use in connection with the development, production, handling, operation, maintenance, storage, detection, identification or dissemination of chemical, biological or nuclear weapons or other nuclear explosive devices or the development, production, maintenance or storage of missiles capable of delivering such weapons.
- II. An export control license shall also be required for the export of dual-use items not listed in Annex I, if the purchasing country or country of destination is subject to an arms embargo imposed by a decision or a common position adopted by the European Council or a decision of the Organisation for Security and Cooperation in Europe (OSCE) or an arms embargo imposed by a binding resolution of the Security Council of the United Nations, and if the exporter has been informed by the authorities referred to in paragraph 1 that the items in question are or may be intended, in their entirety or in part, for a military end-use. For the purposes of this paragraph, 'military end- use' shall mean:
  - a. incorporation into military items listed in the military list of the Kingdom of Denmark;
  - b. use of production, test or analytical equipment and components therefor, for the development, production or maintenance of military items

listed in the abovementioned list;

- c. use of any unfinished products in a plant for the production of military items listed in the abovementioned list.

- III. An export control license shall also be required for the export of dual-use items not listed in Annex I, if the exporter has been informed by the export control authority that the items in question are or may be intended, in their entirety or in part, for use as parts or components of military items listed in the national military list that have been exported from the territory of Greenland without license or in violation of a license prescribed by national legislation of the Kingdom of Denmark (incl. Greenland).
- IV. If an exporter is aware that dual-use items which he proposes to export, not listed in the "control list", are intended, in their entirety or in part, for any of the uses referred to in paragraphs I, II and III he must notify the export control authority, which will decide whether or not it is expedient to make the export concerned subject to an export control license.
- V. The export control authority may adopt or maintain national legislation imposing a license requirement on the export of dual-use items not listed in Annex I if the exporter has grounds for suspecting that those items are or may be intended, in their entirety or in part, for any of the uses referred to in paragraph I.

"The Catch-all rules" imply that if an exporter has "knowledge of" or "reasons to suspect" that the concerned items will be used in relation to weapons of mass destruction or will be applied military in a country subject to arms embargo, the exporter shall apply for an export control license.

**Field 24: Type of license:**

This form can be used for applying for different licenses:

- I. **Individual export control license:**  
This license is used when the global export control license cannot be used and always when the "Catch-

all" provision applies (See field 23).

An individual export license is granted to one specific exporter for the transfer to one end user (ultimate consignee) or consignee outside of Greenland and covers one or more dual use items.

- II. **Global export control license:**

A license granted to one specific exporter for a specific type or category of dual use items, which may be valid for exports to one or more end users and/or in one or more specified countries
